


# Erlanger East Women's Health Best For All

- Chattanooga's "Best Place to Have a Baby" 17 years in a row.






## **BFA Overview & Education**


#### Overview

- 3.30% response rate on average from an average of 268 deliveries over a span of 4 months.
- 100% increase in PREM survey responses within the same period.

#### Education

- Initial Implicit Bias lecture for MBU nurses.
- Yearly system-wide education
- OB Resident doctor education







# Patient Responses & Mitigation

### Mitigation practices

- Specialized Online learning.
   (coming April 2025)
- Continuing Implicit Bias education.
- Labor & Delivery education to begin in April.
- Began acknowledging staff through "Call Out Cards" to highlight respectful patient care.

"My son was in the Nicu and I felt like I was not included in his care and what was going on with him while he was in there and was just told that no news is good news when I asked why I was not being kept informed."

#### Lesson's Learned

- All staff should be included in education.
- Patient demographics make a difference in survey completion.
- Multiple points of contact can allow for increased survey completion.
